8. **Right to Try Act, [S. 204](#)** This bill, **allows terminally ill patients the right to use** certain unapproved, investigational drugs if they have exhausted approved treatment options and are unable to participate in a clinical trial involving the drugs. **Passed Senate and House signed by President Trump on 05/30/2018 became Public Law No: 115-176. NOW LAW**
