By 2030, you will be required to covert, your NYS home to electric heat at an average cost of over \$30,000 per home to upgrade wiring etc, unless the Climate Action Council regulations are blocked by the governor or legislature in 2023!

As we begin to unpack what was hidden in the 2022 budget bills the "All-Electric Building Act" was merged and hidden in the budget, these things take effect after November! NO new building or addition may use gas/oil/ propane/wood heat after January 1, 2024. Plus, the Climate Action Council was granted power to force homeowners and other existing building owners to convert to Electric Heat. The current power grid would need hundreds of new power plants to support the load. Currently electric heat is much more expensive than natural gas, wood, propane, or oil!

- 1. <u>A4604</u> 2023-24 Legislative Session Relates to comprehensive sexuality education in schools
- <u>A04446</u> / <u>S3093</u> Proposes a constitutional amendment to divide the state into three autonomous regions
- <u>A03997</u> / <u>S1636</u> Prohibits a mandatory immunization against the coronavirus

# **Scary Medical Legislation**

Loss of some PARENTAL and personal RIGHTS to NYS government.

- 4. <u>A01913</u> Enacts the "Fairly Applying Individual Requirements for Vaccine Mandates (FAIR Vaccine Mandates) Act Authorizes local governments, by local law, rule or executive order, to require performers, athletes, employees, attendees, and/or any other person or category of persons be vaccinated against COVID-19 to enter a place of entertainment.
- 5. <u>A01448</u> / <u>S2777</u> Changes the default standard on statutory health proxy forms regarding life-sustaining treatment standards Current law protects patients who have completed a health care proxy document appointing a health care agent from being starved or dehydrated to death unless they have specifically authorized it. S 4794 would allow health care agents to decide to starve and dehydrate patients based on judgments by the health care agent even if the agent does not know the patient's wishes. Removing this protection will lead to patients being starved and dehydrated to death, having had no opportunity to express their wishes in that circumstance. AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to the artificial nutrition and hydration decision standard

- 1. <u>A00021</u> <u>S00240</u> NYS Full-Term Abortion bill <u>https://www.nysenate.gov/legislation/bills/2019/s240</u> Allows abortion up to nine months No care for babies born alive. NOW LAW see roll vote below
- 2. <u>S01904</u>, **Property Tax Cap** <u>https://www.nysenate.gov/legislation/bills/2019/S1904</u> Eliminates the expiration of and makes permanent provisions of law establishing the property tax cap. **NOW LAW**
- 3. <u>S01047</u>, <u>A00747</u> Bathroom Bill? Gender Expression Non-Discrimination Act It (It contains the following clause "facilities or privileges thereof" which the courts may interpret as making it crime to prevent men from using ladies rooms! NOW LAW
- <u>S02440</u>, <u>A02683</u> Requires clergy to the report child abuse almost all of the states current require this NYS is among last hold outs; like the other laws nationwide this exempts confession. This also allows lawsuits for child abuse that occurred anytime in the past for one year
